SUBJECT ENRICHMENT ACTIVITY - CLASS VI (MAY 2019)

In the words of Ben Jonson, "Shakespeare is not of any age but for all time". The greatest English dramatist has written about 37 plays and innumerable sonnets. Read the famous play 'As You Like It' by William Shakespeare from the book "Three Shakespeare Comedies" · Write a story review on A-4 sized sheets. A story review should include the following:

1. <u>Introduction</u>

Start with a couple of sentences describing what the book is about. Include some basic facts about the story like the title, author and the story genre (whether it's a mystery, romance, thriller or comedy)

2. <u>Summary</u>

Briefly summarise the story. Discuss the setting, the main character(s) and the main events or problems that the characters experience.

3. Personal reflection

Discuss what you liked and disliked about the story. Who was your favourite character, and why? Did the characters feel real to you? Give reasons to support your opinions.

4. Critical Analysis

Discuss the theme or central idea of the story along with valid examples.

5. Conclusion

In the conclusion, you should evaluate the story and either recommend it or not recommend it to others, depending on whether you think it is worthwhile reading.

- Choose 10 interesting adjectives from the story and find their dictionary meanings.
- Find one synonym and one antonym for all the 10 words.
