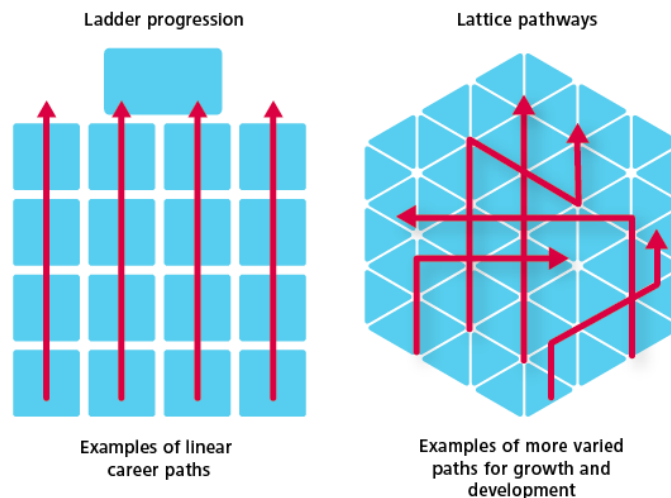

Warm wishes to you from the Career Development Centre of The Lawrence School Lovedale!

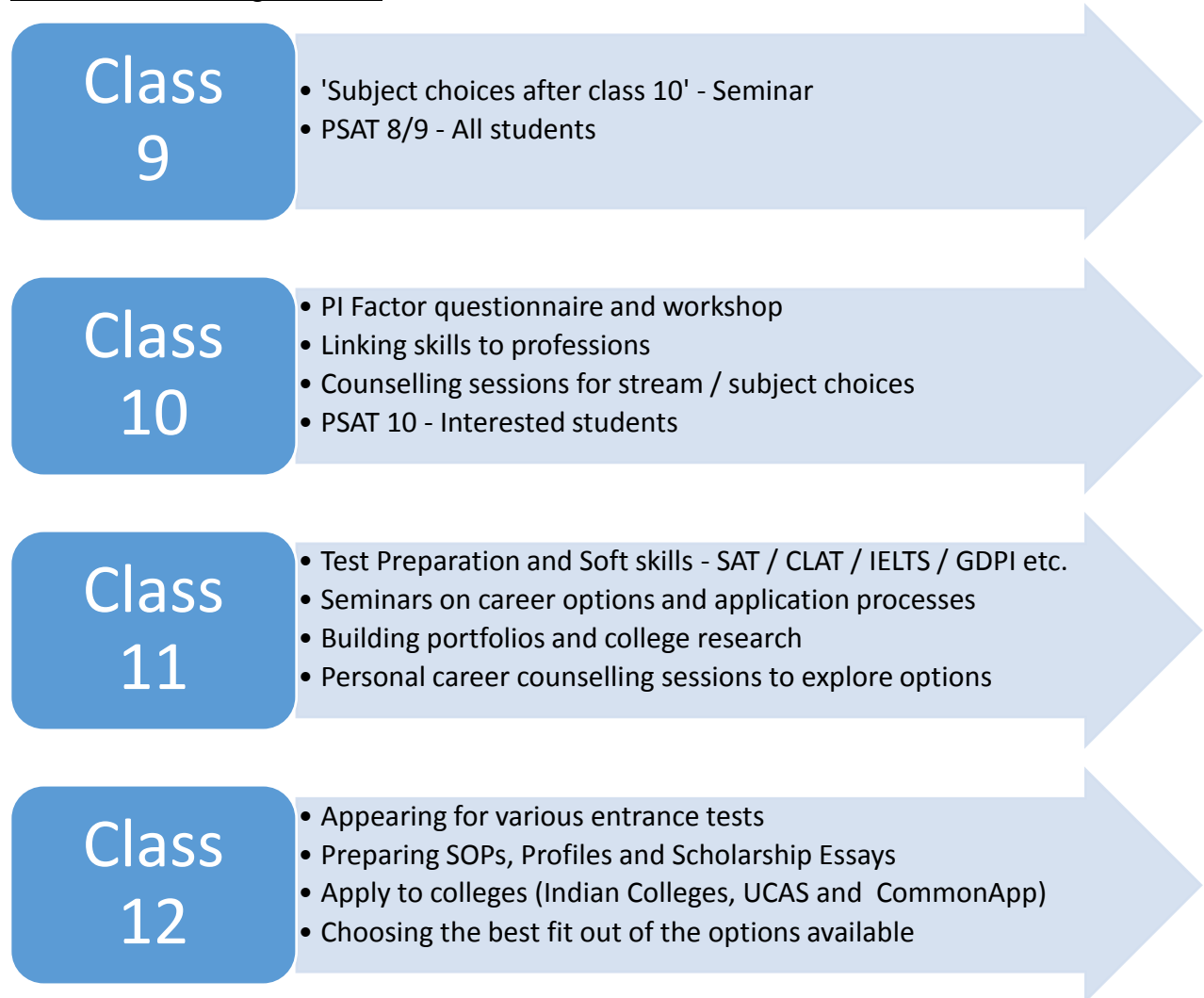
We are glad to inform you that we have had some very good college placements during the year 2016-17, both in India and abroad. It has been our constant endeavor to help and enable students to reach their true potential.

It's a Personality and Intelligence tool based on the Big Five personality factors and Howard Gardner's multiple intelligence concepts.

Test Prep (Preparation classes for entrance tests)

Princeton Review from Coimbatore is currently providing preparation classes for SAT. Since Humanities, is very strong at Lovedale and many of our students tend to write CLAT, we are looking at introducing training for CLAT as well.

For IIT JEE and NEET aspirants, we do not provide comprehensive preparation programs. However, we are planning to introduce sessions that will help our students attempt these tests with confidence.
